

<p>3. <u>Additional Endorsements:</u> The following additional endorsements are available:</p> <p>3.1. Inboard Motors: In order to be able to survey vessels with inboard motors, the surveyor needs to complete the SADSAA Inboard Motor Training Course. This course will be presented by the NSO or one of his deputies. Applications must be submitted by the PSO to the NSO.</p> <p>3.2. Pontoons: In order to be able to survey pontoons, the surveyor needs to complete the SAMSA Pontoon Training Course. Application need to be made to the NSO by the PSO. The NSO will arrange with SAMSA for a course date. <i>All costs involved in the above mention training will be for the applicant's account.</i></p> <p>4. <u>Special Conditions:</u></p> <p>4.1. The surveyor will be required to comply with a professional code of conduct.</p> <p>4.2. The surveyor must undertake to serve the interests of SADSAA and that of the members of public.</p> <p>4.3. The surveyor will be required to adhere to SADSAA and SAMSA regulations.</p> <p>4.4. The appointment will be subject to an annual review and renewal by SADSAA.</p> <p>4.5. They surveyor will only be allowed to operate in the area specified in his/her letter of appointment.</p> <p>4.6. The surveyor will not be allowed to move between Clubs and Provinces without the approval of the respective PSO and the NSO.</p>
